

Terms & Conditions for borrowing CASA resources

We are very pleased that you are interested in borrowing Canadian Agricultural Safety Association (CASA) teaching kits for your agricultural safety event. We have a few 'terms and conditions' to review before you sign and CASA sends!

- You are the Borrower. All resources remain the property of CASA.
- Reservations are first-come-first-serve. Let CASA know when you need the resource(s). We'll advise re availability.
- Shipping costs:
 - **CASA Members:** Provided the resources are available, we will ship the requested item(s) to you, anywhere in Canada, at no cost. You pay for shipping back to the CASA office in Winnipeg *within three days after your event*.
 - **Non-members:** We will send you the resource(s). You pay the transport costs both ways.
- Check the CASA resource(s) as soon as you receive the package. Please notify CASA immediately if anything is missing, broken or working unsafely.
- You are responsible to cover the cost of replacing lost, stolen or broken items up to a maximum of \$500.
- CASA is not responsible for injury or death caused by or arising out of the condition of the borrowed item(s) or by the use of misuse of the item(s).
- You will not use these items for personal gain or profit.
- You understand the above terms and conditions and will abide by the agreement.
- You will take responsibility for any damage to, or theft of, the item(s) and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Canadian Agricultural Safety Association and Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, their agents, representatives and employees from and against all claims, demands, actions and causes of action of third parties that may arise out of this agreement.
