Principles of Sustainability



Our definition of sustainability is based around five guiding principles of **beef sustainability** as defined by the Global Roundtable for Sustainable Beef (GRSB) all underpinned by the need for economic viability.





Benchmarking



Workload for beef producers was also identified as a high risk category, with 54% of respondents exceeding a 48 hour work week for more than 13 weeks of the year.



People Health and Safety Goals

- Create a culture of health and safety across the beef industry supply chain
- Reduce serious, fatal, and fatigue-related incidents by 1.5% per year up to 2030, by supporting education, awareness and improvements in farm and ranch safety
