ROAD SAFETY 1	Before taking to the road this spring, take the time to inspect your farm machinery to make sure it is ready for the road. Pay special attention to lights, make sure each light is working and clear. #RoadSafetyWeek #CdnAg #FarmSafety #AgSafeCanada
ROAD SAFETY 2	Spring has sprung! That means more farm machinery on roadways. Only pass farm machinery when it is safe to do so. Make sure you have a clear line of sight, and plenty of time to get past safely. ROAD SAFETY 3	As spring planting continues, remember that farm machinery is slower than it appears. It is your job to slow down and look for hazards on the road. Farm machinery moves a lot slower than regular traffic. Slow down and drive defensively on rural roadways. It could save your life. #RoadSafetyWeek #CdnAg #FarmSafety #AgSafeCanada
ROAD SAFETY 4	As farming season continues, it is important to look for farm machinery turning on and off the roadways. As farmers move machinery from field to field, be alert for farm machinery turning.
